Subject: Exemption of Toll Tax on import of raw material and export of finished goods for the year -2018-19.


Sir,

In continuation to this office letter No: MSE-J/Dev/Misc-36-V/2771-74 dated: 31.03.2018 and MSE-J/Dev/Misc-36-V/32-44 dated: 28.06.2018 regarding the subject, it is submitted that the Federation of Industries, Jammu has requested to extend the date of exemption as several cases are still being processed by the unit holders.

As such, you are requested to allow the exemption on account of toll tax to the units for another 15 days i.e. upto 31st of July, 2018 to the existing level of 25% on the basis of last year's toll proforma, so that the working of the Industrial units continue smoothly.
